It is now LAW that all Funeral Directors must display their prices.

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Our funerals are bespoke and unique such is the service we provide. We believe in charging a fair price for a unique service you will not find anywhere else. The love, care, and total dedication you and your loved one will receive from all our staff is priceless.

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral directors charges only)

Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)	£2,165.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£550.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£150.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at [both] the funeral director's [branch premises] [and at other] [non-branch premises]	£550.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this coffin will be an oak veneered coffin in a choice of light or dark with a further choice of brass/silver-coloured fittings. All of our coffins are dressed and lined in white damask fabric including a pillow. This is our standard coffin, but we do offer cheaper coffins and other options like cardboard, wicker, solid wood etc. Please do not hesitate to ask.	£520.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer).	£0.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£395.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

Unattended Funeral	Fully Inclusive
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral directors charges only)	£1,000.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1,650.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY

Fees you must pay	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. ¹	£503.00 - £1,000.00
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local resident is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	£375.00 - £1,550
For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. ² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£1,235.00 £1,235.00

NOTE

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales, and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Carlisle Crematorium Cremation Fee. These fees increase every April.	£1,235.00
Minister/Celebrant	£200.00+

BURIALS

Burial in Carlisle/Stanwix/Upperby Cemetery	
Grave purchase for 30 years. These fees increase every April.	£940.00
Grave purchase for 50 years. These fees increase every April.	£1,550.00
Interment fee (opening and using the grave) this is regardless of single or double depth	£1,000.00

Burial in Dalston Cemetery Grave	
Burial in Dalston Cemetery Grave purchase for 100 years for a resident	£915.00
Interment fee (opening and using the grave) single depth	£915.00
Burial in a single depth lawn grave for a resident including interment. Grave purchase (Dalston) Interment Single depth lawn grave for a resident including interment.	£1,830.00

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

Additional Funeral Director Products and Services	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.50 per/mile
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer)	£150.00
Collection and delivery of ashes	FOC
Embalming	£250.00
Funeral Officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc)	£200 - £300
Services supplied outside of normal hours	Price on request
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.
